

A Needle Pulling Thread Magazine Correction Notice

Notice Date: 23 July 2006

Issue: Spring 2006 (Volume 1 Issue 2)

Item: Evelyn Marie Party Dress by Ruth I. Forbes

SKIRT FRONT (Page 31):

Row 2: Beg Shell. *Sk next st. Sc in next st. Sk 2 sts. TS in next st. Sk next st. Sc in next st. Sk next 2 sts. FS in next st. Rep from * e/w End Shell in last st. 20 (22, 24) shells.

Row 12: **Skirt Eyelet Row.** Ch 4. *Sk next st. Dc in next st. Ch 1. Rep from * e/w dc in last sc.

Row 13: Ch 1. *Sc in next ch 1 sp. Sc in next dc. Rep from * e/w sc in last sp, sc in 3rd ch of ch 4. 101 (111, 121) sts.

Note: Parts of the sleeve have been revised. The entire sleeve with revisions is as follows:

SLEEVES (Page 32):

Leaving approx. 18" [45 cm] at beg for seaming, ch. 43 (47, 49).

Row 1: **(RSF)** Dc in 4th ch from hk. Dc in next 9 (5, 3) ch. *2 dc in next ch. Dc in next ch. Rep from * 9 (15, 18) times. Dc in last 10 (6, 4) ch. 51 (61, 66) sts.

Row 2: As Row 2 of Skirt. 10 (12, 13) shells.

Pattern for 2 (3, 3) more rows.

Next Row: **Size 3 mons only:** Ch 1. Sc in bottom of TC. Sc in next 2 dc. *Sk next sc. Work 5 sc across each shell. *Note: For TS, work 2 sc in each ch 2 sp, sc in dc; for FS work 1 sc in each dc.* Rep from * e/w sc in last 3 dc. 51 sts.

Sizes 6 and 9 mons only: Ch 1. Sc in bottom of TC. *Work 5 sc across each shell. Sk next sc. Rep from * e/w sc in last sc. 62 (68) sts.

Note: from this point forward sleeve is not patterned.

Next Row: Ch 3. Dc evenly. 51 (62, 68) sts.

Sleeve Cap Shaping (Page 32):

Working in dc, dec 3 sts each end of next row.

Dec both ends of row (see Note): 1 st next 3 (3, 4) rows, then 2 sts next 2 (3, 3) rows. *Note: Ss in #dec sts, ch 1, dc until #dec sts plus 1 r/r, sc in next st. This pulls in the edges of the sleeve cap to create a puffed effect.* Turn.

Final Row: Ss in next 3 sts. Ch 1. *Dc cl in next 2 sts. Rep from * until 5 (4, 4) sts r/r. Dc in next 1 (0, 0) sts. Sc in next st. Break yarn.
